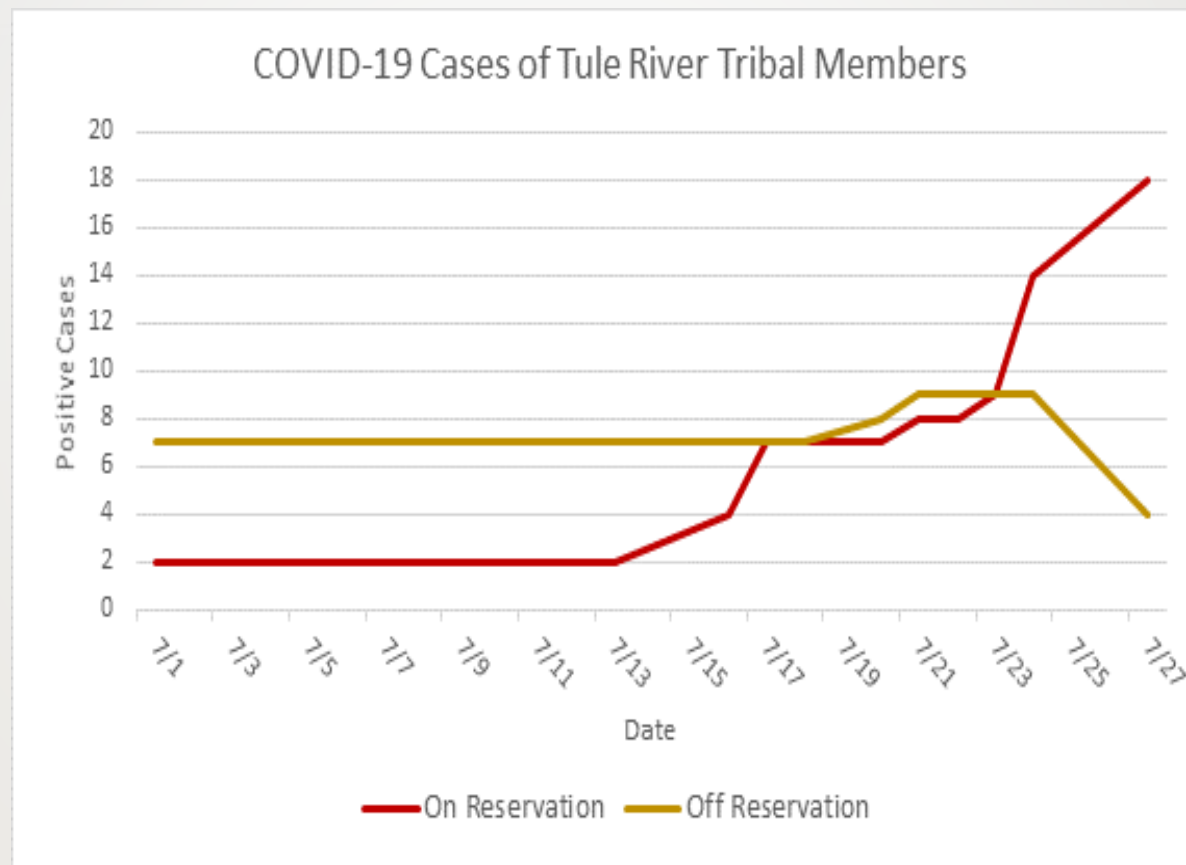
## COVID-19 Update: July 27, 2020

Cases OFF Reservation: 4

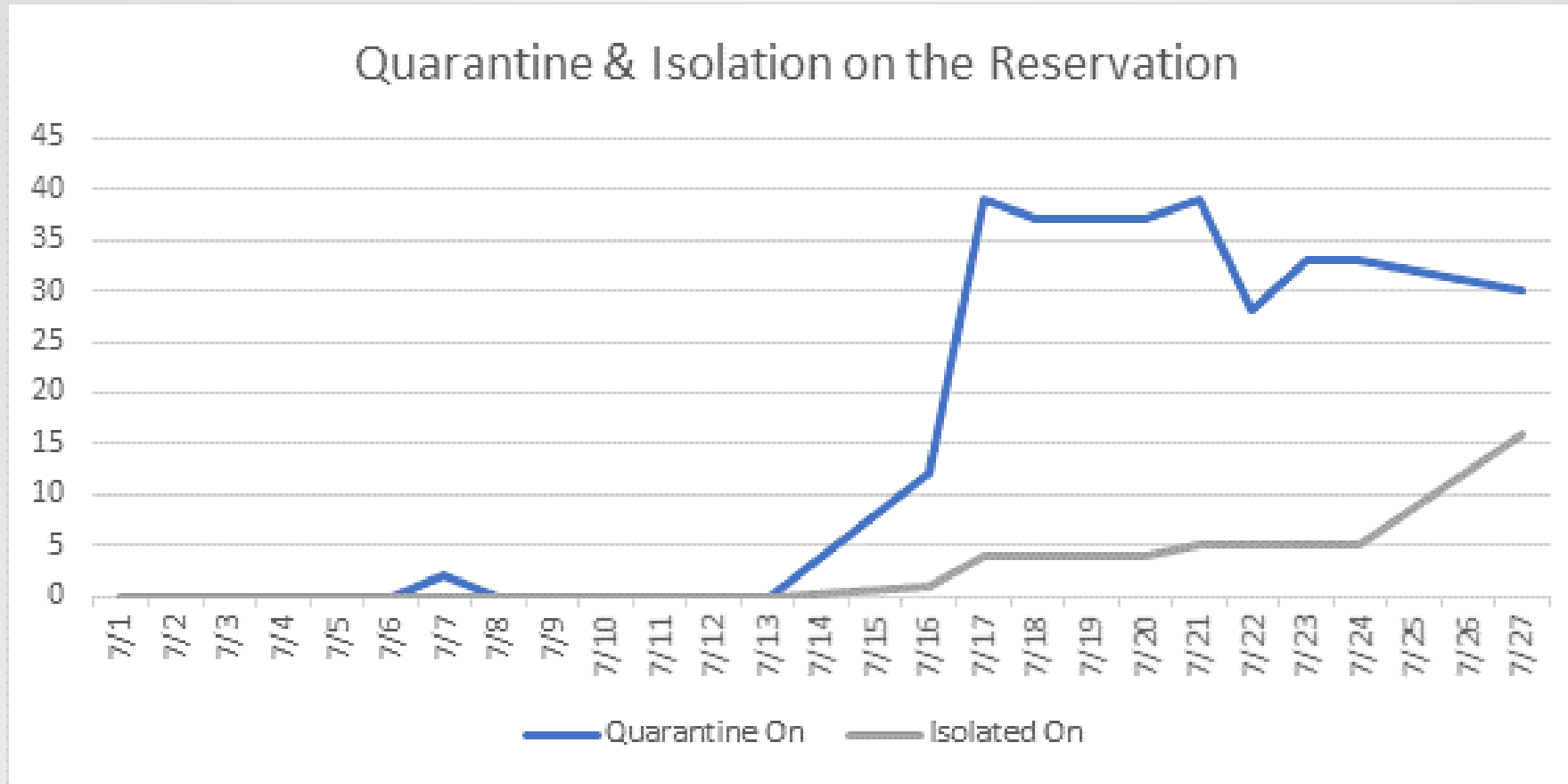
Number in Quarantine: 36


